Permitted workers – maintenance

DHHS has published the [Permitted Work Premises List](#) which includes *essential maintenance for safety and upkeep of public and recreational spaces, such as parks, gardens, golf courses* (see the last page of the list).

Only Permitted Work Premises may operate with on-site operations under the Step 2 restrictions. Volunteer or unpaid work is permitted. Guidance in relation to volunteer requirements can be found at this [link](#).

The Chief Health Officer Directions for organisations operating under Step 2 restrictions in metropolitan Melbourne include:

- the requirement for workplaces to have a [COVIDSafe Plan](#);
- the requirement for employers to complete a [Permitted Worker Permit](#) for every essential employee (including volunteers) travelling to the worksite.
